Remote learning timetable for KS1

As stated in our home learning policy, pupils are expected to complete at least 3 hours learning a day in Reception and KS1 and 4 hours in KS2. We provide 4 – 5 hours each day which equates to the learning time that pupils would receive in school. The timetable below sets out the learning that your child will need to complete each day and how we will provide feedback. Your Child's Class Teacher will contact you on a weekly basis to discuss any concerns that you might have. If you have any questions or queries, please contact a member of staff through your child's year group email and they will get back to you as quickly as they can.

Daily Timings – KS1

Suggested time	Lesson	Information
30 minutes	Phonics	Videos will be posted to Seesaw and the school website to teach the sounds, and strategies that the children need to read those words. Children are to practice writing words using the daily sound and then write some sentences using these words. Photographs of this work should be uploaded to Seesaw. Year 2 are to access their colour reading book via the link on Seesaw. We will begin live phonic lessons after half term as well as 1-to1 tutoring.
30 mins	Reading	Your child needs to read an e-book or a one of their own books every day. Oxford Owl class e-books have been shared on Seesaw, along with the colour of your child's reading book. Extra reading tasks will be set daily through PhonicsPlay, RWI videos, comprehension tasks, 60 second reads, red words and live storytime with teachers.
45 hour	Maths	White Rose maths teaching videos are uploaded to Seesaw each day. Children should watch these and complete the corresponding pages in the workbooks for each unit. Extra resources, maths challenges and games will be added to support the lesson objective when applicable. Photographs of this work should be uploaded to Seesaw. Extra activities are set on EducationCity and TT Rockstars
45 hour	Literacy	Videos and images will be posted into Google Classroom to form the basis of the lesson. Instructions will be posted onto the Powerpoint that is uploaded to Google Classroom each day. Teachers will provide feedback and give next steps to enable children to further develop their work next time. Seesaw activity, letter join and Education city.
30 mins	Foundation subject	Everyday a timetable of foundation subjects including; History, Science, RE, PE, Everton in the Community challenges, art challenges, music challenges, green finger challenges, STEM challenges. As well as daily collective worship. Many challenges designed for families to do together away from the screen to support mental health and well-being.

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
