Remote learning timetable for KS2

As stated in our home learning policy, pupils are expected to complete at least 3 hours learning a day in Reception and KS1 and 4 hours in KS2. We provide 4 – 5 hours each day which equates to the learning time that pupils would receive in school. The timetable below sets out the learning that your child will need to complete each day and how we will provide feedback. Your Child's Class Teacher will contact you on a weekly basis to discuss any concerns that you might have. If you have any questions or queries, please contact a member of staff through your child's year group email and they will get back to you as quickly as they can.

Daily Timings – KS2

Time/ Suggested time	Lesson	Information
20 minutes 8:45am	Maths fluency	Your child will have daily activities set for them to complete on Education City and TT Rockstars linked to weekly objectives or recall of key number facts.
20 minutes	Spelling	Your child spends 20 mins per day completing spelling practice. They learn a new spelling rule and practise these in different ways on Education City. During the closure, your child will need to practise spellings each day. They can write their spellings into new sentences, devise mnemonics to help them remember and complete some dictated sentences from you. Any examples of additional spelling practice can be sent to teachers through Seesaw.
1 hour	English	A mixture of videos from Oak Academy, images and work packs will be posted onto Seesaw to form the basis of the lesson. Instructions will be posted onto Seesaw and the school website each day. Teachers will feed back and provide next steps to further improve their work.
20-30 mins	Reading	Your child completes 20 minutes of reading at school each day and this needs to continue at home. Oxford Owl Class logins have been provided, along with the colour of your child's reading book. Instructions of how to access these texts have also been included in your home learning folders. Quality texts have been selected and questions linked to the content domains are set on a Powerpoint. Children can answer these questions verbally or with written answers through Seesaw. The Oak Academy also has texts that your child can access at home. Links to these texts will be posted onto the Powerpoint that is uploaded to Seesaw.

1 hour	Maths	Your child's class teacher will put White Rose Maths teaching video links onto the Powerpoint that is uploaded to Seesaw. There will be worksheets linked to each lesson for your child to complete. These will be uploaded to Seesaw for pupils to complete on screen. Workbooks are also available to collect from the school office.
20 minutes	Wellbeing	Your child's class teacher will set a mindfulness activity on Seesaw using resources such as Mind Yeti, Place2be and Oak Academy.
1 hour	Science and non-core subjects	Your child's class teacher will share a list of other subject areas and learning tasks for your child to continue their learning across the curriculum. This will be in a range of subjects, for example science, art, DT, PSHE, RE, history, geography etc. It will not be every one of these subjects, it will depend on what your child would currently be learning about if they were in school. It is expected that your child will complete one of these sessions per day.
